Northwestern Medicine has long-standing roots in community service and volunteering to support local and national organizations that are committed to building stronger, healthier communities.

Team NM members are Northwestern Medicine employees and physicians who share their time and talent through organized volunteer opportunities across Chicagoland.

Types of volunteer events

- Traditional volunteer events involve supporting

 a charity organization through hands-on service.

 Examples include helping with a 5K walk, at a food

 pantry or with a beautification project.
- Ongoing volunteer events depend on volunteers to commit to a regular cadence of service, by offering reoccurring scheduled volunteer time. These may include regular time slots to serve at traditional volunteer events, tutoring and mentoring.

- Skills-based volunteer events allow team members to use their unique talents and skills to serve an organization without charging a fee. These may be opportunities to do clinical, legal or administrative work that supports a community partner.
- Collection drives are organized by hospital departments to support a variety of causes. Options may include food or clothing drives.
